### **If you are scheduled for a *Stress Test*:**

Medications: Do not take any Beta Blockers, Calcium Channel Blockers, Nitrates, or Theophylline medications one day (24 hrs) before the test. All other medications take as scheduled. If you have any questions regarding medications please call our nuclear medicine confirmation line at (480) 430-0571.

**No Caffeine 24 hours prior to test  
No food or drink 4 hours prior to test**

## **Confirming your Appointment**

Please be aware that we must speak to you directly on the telephone in order to confirm your appointment. Please call (480) 430-0571, between 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., two (2) business days before your appointment. If you must leave a voice mail, please leave your name, a phone number where you can be reached, and say that you are calling to confirm a nuclear stress test appointment. We will call you back as soon as we can. **NOTE: Leaving a voice mail message does not confirm your appointment.** We will begin trying to call you the morning before your stress test if you have not yet confirmed.

## **Test Summaries**

### **(Part 1): Stress Portion (3 to 4 hours):**

You will be given a drug, Adenosine, which will dilate the blood vessels around your heart to simulate exercise. In some circumstances you may also be asked to walk on a treadmill.

After about three minutes we will inject a radioactive material (myoview) which will be absorbed by the heart muscle.

Following this procedure you will wait in our waiting room for 30-45 minutes; this allows your heart rate and body to fully recover. Images are then taken of your heart with our nuclear medicine imaging camera.

You **must** confirm your stress test appointment by 2:00 pm the day prior to your scheduled stress test appointment.

### **(Part 2): Resting Portion (1 ½ to 2 hours):**

#### **ON ANOTHER DAY**

You will be asked to return to complete the stress test during the same week or the week following. We will inject the radioactive material (Myoview) again. After the injection, we will ask you to wait 30-45 minutes in our waiting room, after which we will again take more pictures of your heart with the nuclear medicine imaging camera for approximately 15 minutes.

You **must** confirm your rest scan appointment by 2:00 pm the day prior to your scheduled rest scan appointment.

### **Monitoring:**

During all stress tests, trained personnel will monitor your condition with EKG and blood pressure monitoring equipment. Please communicate any concerns before the test begins.
